RE : CPI Adjustment to Major Source Annual Fees

DATE : September 19, 2023

In accordance with the Air Pollution Control Rules of the State of North Dakota, NDAC 33.1-15-23-04.8, the major source (Title V) annual fee rates and limits will be adjusted based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the 12-month period ending August 31 each year. The average, unadjusted CPI for all items during the period that ended August 31, 2023 was +3.7 percent. The table below lists the fee changes.

Item	2022 Rate/Ton or Minimum Fee (\$)	CPI Adjustment Factor	2023 Rate/Ton or Minimum Fee (\$)
Regulated contaminants for fee calculations*, other than HAP (per ton)	18.38	+3.7%	19.06
Section 112(b) contaminants, HAP (per ton)	38.28	+3.7%	39.70
Minimum fee	765.63	+3.7%	793.96

\* Excludes greenhouse gases

The adjusted fee rates are effective January 1, 2024 and will be used to calculate the July 2024 annual bill based on calendar year 2023 actual emissions.
