RE : CPI Adjustment to Major Source Annual Fees

DATE : September 16, 2024

In accordance with the Air Pollution Control Rules of the State of North Dakota, NDAC 33.1-15-23-04.8, the major source (Title V) annual fee rates and limits are adjusted based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the 12-month period ending August 31 each year. The average, unadjusted CPI for all items during the period that ended August 31, 2024 was +2.5 percent. The table below lists the fee changes.

Item	2023 Rate/Ton or Minimum Fee (\$)	CPI Adjustment Factor	2024 Rate/Ton or Minimum Fee (\$)
Regulated contaminants for fee calculations*, other than HAP (per ton)	19.06	+2.5%	19.54
Section 112(b) contaminants, HAP (per ton)	39.70	+2.5%	40.69
Minimum fee	793.96	+2.5%	813.81

* Excludes greenhouse gases

The adjusted fee rates are effective January 1, 2025 and will be used to calculate the July 2025 annual bill based on calendar year 2024 actual emissions.
