Pursuant to the Air Pollution Control Rules of the State of North Dakota, the Department of Environmental Quality (Department) has reviewed the updated permit applications received August 8, 2025, to obtain Permits to Construct to increase the compressor engine emission limits for the Flickertail Compressor Station and the Rough Rider Compressor Station both located in Williams County, North Dakota.

Before making final determination on the draft Permits to Construct, the Department must first solicit public comment by means of the enclosed public notices. As indicated in the notices, the public comment periods will begin on January 28, 2026, and end February 27, 2026.
