

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE AN
AIR POLLUTION CONTROL
PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT

Take notice that the North Dakota Department of Health proposes to issue an Air Pollution Control Permit to Construct to Oasis Midstream Services in accordance with the North Dakota Air Pollution Control Rules. The project involves an expansion to increase natural gas processing collected from well sites from the current 80 MMscfd of natural gas process capacity to 280 MMscfd at the Wild Basin Gas Plant located at NW1/4 Sec 35 T151N R98W near Watford City in McKenzie County, ND.

A 30-day public comment period for the proposed permit will begin December 21, 2017 and end on January 19, 2018. Direct comments, in writing, to the North Dakota Department of Health, Division of Air Quality, 918 E Divide Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58501-1947. Comments must be received during the public comment period to be considered in the final permit determination.

A public meeting regarding issuance of the Permit to Construct will be held if a significant degree of public interest exists as determined by the Department. Requests for a public meeting must be received in writing by the Department before the end of the public comment period.
