All fluid burned up and the affected area was 18 feet by 9 feet. MSO shut the all wells in. After investigating, the MSO found that the low-pressure RKO pump was gas locked. Specialist arrived and was able to bleed gas out of pump and remove fluid from the RKO. No fluid left location.
