Risk Evaluation:

Before the spill was cleaned up, there was a minor health risk due to exposure to fluid or the flammability of oil.

Areal Extent:

Spill was contained in berm.

Potential Env. Impacts:

All fluid was contained within the berm and spill has been vacuumed up promptly, so there is unlikely to be any effects to the environment. Due to the short period of time that this spill was left in the berm, only a negligible amount of fluid would be able to leech into the groundwater or soil, and any fluid that did would have a concentration of over 90% salt water.

Action Taken/Planned:

Spill was naturally contained by berm, which made cleanup a straightforward task.

This incident was the fault of a subcontractor failing to honor their portion of a contract by failing to show up, or at the very least a miscommunication between two subcontractors, thus the only action Samson could take at this time would be seeking other subcontractors or other human resource

related actions. Systems to contain a small spill worked as they were intended to.

Wastes Disposal Location:

All recovered wastes will be disposed of promptly in a local SWD well.
