Did not traverse to the area impacted due to the flare being directed to the east and at a height approximately similar to the impacted area. Talked to company rep onsite and he indicated that they will have to flare until Oneok gets the gas line to the site. Next inspection should occur when the wind is from the east, south or when the system is hooked up to the gas line so flaring drops.

It appears the area was lightly scraped up at sometime. Vegetation is starting to grow, but still visible stained soil. The area of impact is on USFS land. Will contact them to see what they want done. Also will contact the company rep to see if soil samples were collected for the site. No surface water was impacted in the area.
