Based on direction, further southeast is a dirt road (30th Street NW or County Road 20), but no visible staining on the road or past the road to the southeast. Visibly stained grasses have been cut, only the stubble remains. According to report contact, they are waiting for One Call to mark lines before going in and scraping the ground. Follow-up in spring/summer to confirm vegetative recovery.
