 300 BBLs were contained inside concrete containment and will be pumped back into the facility tanks. 2 BBLs that sprayed over containment will be removed with hydrovac and placed back into the facility tanks. We will dispose of any solids collected in the hydrovac as an approved oilfield RCRA exempt landfill that has not been determined at this time.
