Well was shut in. A vacuum truck was called to recover ponded fluids. Frozen ground and snow cover limited fluids ground penetration and movement. Equipment was used to scrape up the fluids. Less than 10 gallons misted off site to the NE. The impacted areas were snow covered and were scraped up with no ground contamination.
