Minimal impact to facility soil within the pump-house berm.

Action Taken/Planned:

All power to the well and pump was shut off and a proper lock out tag out procedure was completed on all appropriate valves. A truck and hydro-vac sucked up all standing fluids. A one call has been put in place and all impacted material will be taken to an approved disposal. An NDIC inspector met onsite with Whiting employees and has reviewed and approved Whiting's clean-up plan. The pump and packing will be fixed and pins will be added to the packing nuts to ensure that they can not back-out in the future.

Wastes Disposal Location:

Fluids sucked up by the truck, were disposed of at Landtech Enterprises, LLC salt water disposal. All

of the remaining fluids were sucked up by the hydro-vac and were taken to Republic Services. All impacted solids will be taken to an approved disposal, after the one call goes through and all lines have been cleared and confirmed by all parties.
