The Wold 1 well was shut in and all fluids released from the overflow of the tank recovered with a vacuum truck. Investigation will determine what caused the plug in the discharge line and what mechanical or chemical treatments must occur. The discharge line will be pressure tested before being placed back into service.

All recovered fluids will be disposed on in a Cobra operated disposal well. Any excavated soils will be disposed of at a proper waster diposal facility.
