Cause of Incident:

Truck entered round about at too high of a speed and rolled over. Another trucks was on site shortly to offload the rolled truck. The rolled truck tipped over on the concrete and never left the concrete. Some antifreeze (couple gallons) and some diesel (couple gallons) spilled on the concrete. Some water from the trailer dripped from the top hatch. Most of what dripped out hit the concrete, with a little bit that hit the dirt on the shoulder of the road.

Risk Evaluation:

Potential Env. Impacts:

Minimal impacts. No spillage went into any water sources. Minimal water went into soil. About 10 gallons worth of dirt was taken from the side of the road from spilled water.

Action Taken/Planned:

Another trucks was on site shortly and hooked up to the rolled truck. This stopped the dripping from the trailer. Floor dry (100 lbs) was spread to absorb the antifreeze, diesel, and water on the concrete. About 2 five gallon buckets of dirt from the shoulder of the road were removed from the water that spilled on the dirt.

Wastes Disposal Location:

All spilled liquids, absorbent, and dirt were taken to Sorenson SWD
