Piles of scrap metal and other associated rail debris are around the site, which made locating the exact location where material was dug up difficult, but it did not appear any staining from the incident remains in the ground. There is a pile of material both on and under a plastic tarp, which the CP personnel indicated was the impacted material, by some of the scrap piles. No further onsite follow-up required, but documentation needs to be obtained of exact incident location.
