Cause of Incident:

Around 1 am on 02/05 one of our trucks was stuck on the lease road. Another truck came to offload the stuck truck around 3 am in order to assist getting the truck unstuck. At approximately 10 AM we were notified that there was a spill between where the two trucks were transferring fluids.

The ground is frozen. We believe the only contamination that occurred was snow. We will conduct soil testing to ensure this is the case.

#### Potential Env. Impacts:

Possible Soil or surface water in the depression. This is currently frozen.

### Action Taken/Planned:

The spill ran down the side of the lease road to a low spot (depression) where it is containted. We will be utilizing a hydrovac and skidsteer to remove the production water and snow.

#### Wastes Disposal Location:

Fluids will be filtered and disposed at approved Salt Water Disposal. Any contamined soils will be

taken to approved solids disposal.
