According to the responsible party, the leak occurred in the housing of the pump where it filled up the housing of the pump and overflowed onto the concrete pad. It was determined that the release involved 1300 gallons of #1 diesel and 25 gallons of #2 diesel. A majority of the released diesel was contained to the pad, however, some did migrate off of the pad and onto the gravel driveway belonging to NorthStar CO-OP. Some of the impacted gravel was scraped up and placed in collection area. Responsible party has been given the contact information for the UST program and for the AST insurance program.

Follow-up is necessary to ensure proper cleanup.
