# Helpful Hints to Surveyors

## **Safety Tips**

- 1. Wear boots, long pants and a hat. Consider sunblock, insect repellant (especially for ticks), and lip balm.
- 2. Be cautious of dogs and other animals. Snakes, bees, and skunks often live in scrap piles.
- 3. Travel with a buddy, and tell your family when you will get home.
- 4. Don't climb or crawl on waste.
- 5. Avoid edges of pits, they may be unstable.

## **Customer Relations Tips**

- 1. Identify who you are and what you are doing.
- 2. Explain there is no cost to the scrap owner or landowner, and they are rewarded by the removal of scrap, car bodies, and vehicle components at no expense to them.
- 3. Stress all releases of scrap are voluntary and that your organization is being paid just to find it and submit survey forms.

## **Environmental Tips**

- 1. Scrap appliances avoid sharp edges, animals.
- 2. Please count all tires.
- Agriculture chemicals tell landowner to call ND Dept. of Agriculture at (701) 328-0000 (Project Safe Send). This is a no risk, completely FREE disposal program.
- 4. Used oils/fuels offer used oil pamphlet.
- 5. Count and identify all farm machinery, scrap metal, etc.
- 6. Be as specific as possible in descriptions.
