Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Awards Loans to Three Cities

BISMARCK, N.D. – The Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program awarded loans to three cities in September.

- Carson - \$1,500,000 to rehabilitate cast-iron water mains, service lines and associated valves and hydrants that have exceeded their design lives.
- Larimore - \$119,500 to make control system improvements to the water treatment plant and well control panel, as well as to install a generator for the city's second well.
- Rugby - \$285,000 to bore and install fusible pipe to transport raw water from the city's wells to the water treatment plant. The new pipe will replace a transmission main that has exceeded its design life.

The DWSRF Program is administered by the North Dakota Department of Health with funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The program offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Safe Drinking Water Act. DWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide the funding necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects and supplies vital water resources.
