Dickinson and Grand Forks receive Clean Water State Revolving Fund loans

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality announced today that its Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program awarded loans to two cities in July.

- Dickinson - \$2,370,000 for upgrades to Lift Station No. 1 to ensure current and future residents have continued wastewater service.
- Grand Forks - \$1,425,000 for improvements to the city's wastewater treatment facility.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency provides part of the funding for the CWSRF Program, which offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Clean Water Act. CWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide the funding necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our vital water resources.
