## **Cavalier and Riverdale receive Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loans**

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality announced today that its Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program awarded loans to two cities in July.

- Cavalier - \$3,095,000 for construction of a water tower and replacement of cast iron water mains. The project will ensure the water supply is safely stored and transported.
- Riverdale - \$1,961,000 for replacement of a water tower and asbestos cement pipe to safeguard water storage and transport.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency provides part of the funding for the DWSRF Program, which offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Safe Drinking Water Act. DWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide the funding necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our vital water resources.
