Updated volume reported for oil spill in Walsh County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) has received an updated number for the volume of oil leaked from a pipeline in Walsh County. The volume is currently reported at 9,120 barrels. The pipeline is operated by TC Energy.

The incident occurred about 3 miles northwest of Edinburg on Oct. 29 and was reported the same day. The release impacted a wetland area.

TC Energy is working to determine the cause of the spill. Personnel from the NDDEQ are at the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.
