Oil spill reported in McKenzie County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) has been notified of an oil spill resulting from a pipeline leak on a well pad in McKenzie County. The above-ground pipeline is operated by New Horizon Resources, LLC.

The incident occurred about 15 miles north of Alexander on Oct. 31 and was reported the same day.

Initial estimates indicate approximately 200 barrels of oil were released and impacted pastureland.

Personnel from the NDDEQ will inspect the site and monitor the investigation and remediation.
