Updated numbers reported for oil spill in Williams County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) has received an estimate of the amount of oil spilled from a pipeline leak on a crude oil gathering line in Williams County. The pipeline is operated by Hiland Crude.

The incident occurred about a mile northeast of McGregor on Oct. 17 and was reported the same day. However, the initial report did not include an estimate of the amount of oil released.

An updated report provided on Nov. 12 estimates approximately 192 barrels of oil were released and impacted cropland.

Personnel from the NDDEQ have inspected the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.
