Produced water spill reported in Renville County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) has been notified of a produced water spill from a pipeline rupture in Renville County. The 3-inch fiberglass pipeline is operated by Cobra Oil & Gas Corporation.

The incident occurred about 2 miles north of Sherwood on January 13, and it was reported the same day. The cause of the pipeline rupture is still under investigation.

Cobra Oil & Gas Corporation estimates that approximately 200 barrels of produced water were released impacting agricultural land.

Personnel from the NDDEQ are inspecting the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.
