Tri-County Water District receives Drinking Water SRF loan

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality announced today that its Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program awarded a \$1.61 million loan to Tri-County Water District in January.

Tri-County Water District, headquartered in Petersburg, will use the loan to construct transmission lines and an elevated storage tank. The rural water project will supply 85 additional users with a clean and safe drinking water source.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency provides part of the funding for the DWSRF Program, which offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Safe Drinking Water Act. DWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide the funding necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our vital water resources.
