Fertilizer spill due to vehicle collision in Cavalier County

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) has been notified of a fertilizer spill caused by a semi collision. The spill occurred Thursday, Oct. 1, approximately four miles north of Nekoma.

The initial notification estimates 200 pounds of fertilizer was released, along with an unknown amount of diesel fuel from the vehicle's fuel tank. The spill impacted a wetland.

Personnel from the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality are heading to the scene and will continue to monitor the investigation and cleanup.
