Clean Water State Revolving Fund loans awarded to two communities

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) announced today that its Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program awarded loans to two communities in July.

- **Cavalier** received a \$450,000 loan to extend the sanitary sewer line to nine residences currently served by aging individual septic systems. This project will ensure the safe transmission of sanitary sewer for these residents.
- **Fargo** received two loans totaling \$4,620,000 to reclaim and redevelop a former landfill site that is not meeting leachate regulations. The project will allow for additional disposal volume and meet current landfill standards.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency provides part of the CWSRF Program funding, which offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Clean Water Act. CWSRF programs operate nationwide to provide funding to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our vital water resources.

Loans are awarded to projects listed on the NDDEQ project priority list based on project eligibility and repayment ability. Please contact the NDDEQ regarding specific detail on any of the projects mentioned above.
