

Agencies encouraged to apply for state clean diesel grant awards

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality is pleased to release the FY2022 State Clean Diesel Grant Program application. Schools, cities, counties, and other government agencies that require larger diesel-powered vehicles are encouraged to apply for State Clean Diesel Grant awards.

Environmental Quality will issue approximately \$393,000 in awards funded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to purchase new or newer, diesel-powered, zero-emission, hybrid, or alternatively fueled vehicles. The purpose of the funding is to reduce diesel emissions in accordance with the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act of the Energy Policy Act of 2010. To date, 110 older vehicles in North Dakota have been replaced using this funding, with a reduction in air emissions of about 200 tons over the lifetime of those vehicles.
