## Three State Revolving Fund loans awarded for landfill, water and sanitary sewer projects

BISMARCK, N.D. - The State Revolving Fund (SRF) programs, jointly administered by the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality and the North Dakota Public Finance Authority, awarded three loans for a landfill project and a water and sanitary sewer project in September 2023.

- **Fargo** received a \$11,348,000 Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan for the reclamation and redevelopment of a former landfill site to assist in meeting leachate regulations. This will remove a potential environmental liability and provide the region with additional solid waste management disposal volume that meets current landfill standards.
- **Mapleton** received a \$1,975,000 CWSRF loan and a \$825,000 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) loan towards a project that will replace the community's water and sanitary sewer mains. This project will reduce repairs and improve system reliability.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency provides part of the SRF programs' funding, which offers below-market interest rate loans to political subdivisions for financing projects authorized under the Clean Water Act and Safe Drinking Water Act. SRF programs operate nationwide to provide funding to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our vital water resources.

Loans are awarded to projects listed on the project priority list based on project eligibility determined by the Department of Environmental Quality and the Public Finance Authority's review of repayment ability. The Public Finance Authority is overseen by the North Dakota Industrial Commission, consisting of Governor Doug Burgum as chairman, Attorney General Drew H. Wrigley, and Agriculture Commissioner Doug Goehring.
