## Produced water release reported in Williams County

<u>Correction</u>: The first issue to this news release incorrectly stated the release happened 11 miles southwest of Tioga. It occurred 11 miles **southeast** of Tioga.

BISMARCK, N.D. – On Tuesday, Feb. 6, Enable Bakken Crude Services, LLC notified state agencies of a produced water release from a pipeline they operate about 11 miles southeast of Tioga. Produced water, or brine, is a by-product of oil production.

Enable estimates 6,478 barrels (272,076 gallons) of production water or brine released from the pipeline, impacting pastureland and a stock pond.

North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality personnel have been on location and will continue to oversee the remediation.
