

Crude oil spill reported in Golden Valley County

BISMARCK, N.D. – Cobra Oil & Gas Corporation notified state agencies on Sunday, April 28, of a crude oil release from a pipeline they operate located approximately seven miles southwest of Medora.

Cobra estimates the pipeline malfunction released approximately 10 barrels (420 gallons) of crude oil, impacting an unnamed Garner Creek tributary and range land.

Personnel from the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality are working with the responsible party on cleanup and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.

Federal and state laws require that operators report the spillage of any materials that may pollute water, air or soil. Visit spill.nd.gov for more information about North Dakota's Unified Spill Reporting System notifications and the public access tool.
