

## Produced water spill reported in Stark County

BISMARCK, N.D. – Scout Energy Management LLC has notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality of a produced water spill resulting from a pipeline leak in Stark County. The incident occurred in Dickinson on June 4 and impacted a wetland. This spill currently poses no threat to human health and safety.

Produced water is a by-product of oil and gas development. Scout Energy Management LLC estimates approximately 15 barrels (630 gallons) of produced water released from the pipeline.

Personnel from Environmental Quality have inspected the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.
