

Crude Oil Spill in Williams County

BISMARCK, N.D. – Savage Services Corporation notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality of a crude oil spill from a tank at a storage facility they operate in Williams County approximately 6 miles southwest of Trenton on Thursday, July 11.

Savage estimates the storage tank released approximately 2,000 barrels (84,000 gallons) of crude oil into the secondary containment on site. Currently, there is no known impact to waters of the state.

Personnel from Environmental Quality are working with the responsible party on cleanup and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.

Federal and state laws require operators to report the spillage of any materials that may pollute water, air or soil. Visit spill.nd.gov for more information about North Dakota's Unified Spill Reporting System notifications and the public access tool.
