Grayson Mills reports produced water spill in Williams County

BISMARCK, N.D. – Grayson Mills Operating notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality of a produced water spill resulting from well equipment malfunction in Williams County on Wednesday, Oct. 30.

The company estimates that approximately 497 barrels (20,874 gallons) of produced water were released, with about 3 barrels (126 gallons) impacting rangeland. The incident occurred approximately 7 miles from Williston.

Personnel from the Department of Environmental Quality are en route to the site and are working with the responsible party on cleanup efforts. They will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.

Federal and state laws require operators to report the spillages of any materials that may pollute water, air or soil. Visit spill.nd.gov for more information about North Dakota's Unified Spill Reporting System notifications and the public access tool.
