

## Source water spill reported in McHenry County

BISMARCK, N.D. – Murex Petroleum Corporation has notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) of a source water spill resulting from a tank overflow in McHenry County. The incident occurred March 23 approximately 9 miles northeast of Glenburn and impacted crop land.

Murex reported approximately 500 barrels (21,000 gallons) of source water were released from a tank. Source water is water from an underground formation and consists of water that has elevated levels of total dissolved solids.

Personnel from the NDDEQ will be inspecting the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.
