Environmental spill reported in McKenzie County

BISMARCK, N.D. – Harvest Midstream recently notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) of a Crude oil release on December 8th, 2025.

Harvest Midstream estimates 188 barrels (7,896 gallons) of crude oil was released, the majority of which stayed on the well pad. Approximately 38 bbls released off location impacting the surrounding ranch land.

Personnel from the NDDEQ are working with Harvest Midstream on cleanup, have inspected the site and will continue to monitor the remediation.

Federal and state laws require operators to report the spillage of any materials that may pollute water, air or soil. Visit spill.nd.gov for more information about North Dakota's Unified Spill Reporting System notifications and the public access tool.
