

## Produced water spill reported in Billings County

BISMARCK, N.D. – Scout Energy Management, LLC, has notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) of a produced water spill resulting from a pipeline leak in Billings County. The incident occurred on Dec. 15 approximately 4.5 miles south of Medora and impacted a rangeland drainage to a creek.

Produced water is a byproduct of oil and gas development. Scout Energy Management, LLC, estimates approximately 450 barrels (18,900 gallons) were released from the pipeline.

NDDEQ personnel have inspected the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.
