

## **Correction: Source water spill reported in Bottineau County**

BISMARCK, N.D. – Cobra Oil and Gas Corporation has notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) of a source water spill from a pipeline release Bottineau County. The incident occurred on December 17<sup>th</sup> approximately 5 miles northwest of Newburg and impacted crop land.

Source water is water from an underground formation with elevated levels of total dissolved solids. Source water and injection wells are used for enhanced oil recovery. Cobra Oil and Gas Corporation reported approximately 150 barrels (6,300 gallons) of source water were released from a tank.

Personnel from the NDDEQ have inspected the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.
