Produced water spill reported in Bowman County

BISMARCK, N.D.- MMGL MT I LLC recently notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) of a Produced water release on June 16, 2026. The release occurred 7.5 miles southeast of Marmarth, North Dakota in Bowman County.

MMGL MT I LLC estimates 700 barrels (29,400 gallons) of Produced water was released from a pipeline flowing over the adjacent pasture into the Little Missouri River.

Produced water is a by-product of oil and gas production.

Personnel from the NDDEQ are working with the responsible party on cleanup and will continue to monitor the remediation.

Federal and state laws require operators to report the spillage of any materials that may pollute water, air or soil. Visit spill.nd.gov for more information about North Dakota's Unified Spill Reporting System notifications and the public access tool.
