Produced water spill reported in Williams County

BISMARCK, N.D. Glacier Peak Midstream recently notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) of a Produced water release on June 16, 2026. The release occurred 1 mile west of Williston, North Dakota in Williams County.

Glacier Peak Midstream estimates 400 barrels (16,800 gallons) of Produced water were released from a pipeline impacting the surrounding pasture before entering a tributary to Sand Creek.

Produced water is a by-product of oil and gas production.

Personnel from the NDDEQ are working with the responsible party on cleanup, have inspected the site and will continue to monitor the remediation.

Federal and state laws require operators to report the spillage of any materials that may pollute water, air or soil. Visit spill.nd.gov for more information about North Dakota's Unified Spill Reporting System notifications and the public access tool.
