Produced water spill reported in Stark County

BISMARCK, N.D. – Browning Oil Company, Inc. has notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) of a produced water spill resulting from a pipeline leak in Stark County. The incident occurred on September 5, 2026, approximately 4 miles southwest of Dickinson.

Browning Oil Company, Inc. estimates approximately 353 barrels (14,826 gallons) of produced water were released, impacting an agricultural field. Produced water is a byproduct of oil and gas production.

NDDEQ personnel are inspecting the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation.
