Notice is hereby given that the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) will hold a public hearing at 11:00 a.m. on January 8, 2020, at the Environmental Training Center, 2639 East Main Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota.

The purpose of the hearing will be to present the draft fiscal year 2020 Intended Use Plan and Project Priority List developed by the NDDEQ as part of the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (CWSRF) Program. The CWSRF Program was established by the Clean Water Act (CWA) Amendments of 1987 to help communities finance the costs of wastewater treatment and other water pollution control improvements needed to achieve or maintain CWA compliance.

All interested parties are invited to appear and present comments. Comments must be received by February 12, 2020 to be considered.
