Notice is hereby given that the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) will hold a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on November 5, 2020, at the Environmental Training Center, 2639 East Main Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. Individuals attending in person will be required to submit to temperature checks, wear masks, and maintain physical distancing of six feet from other individuals. Individuals may also attend remotely by calling 1-866-497-7490.

The purpose of the hearing will be to present and receive comments on the draft 2021 Intended Use Plan and Project Priority List developed by the NDDEQ as part of the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) program. The Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) Amendments of 1996 authorized a DWSRF to assist public water systems in financing the costs of infrastructure improvements needed to achieve or maintain SDWA compliance.

All interested parties are invited to appear and present comments.
