Purpose of Public Notice

The Department intends to reissue the following North Dakota Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NDPDES) Discharge Permit under the authority of Section 61-28-04 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Facility Description

The reapplication is for a petroleum refinery with a maximum design throughput of 74,000 barrels of crude oil per day. The refinery continually discharges an average of 0.9 million gallons per day of treated process wastewater and area runoff. All discharges are to the Missouri River, a Class I stream.

Tentative Determinations

Proposed effluent limitations and other permit conditions have been made by the Department. They assure that State Water Quality Standards and applicable provisions of the FWPCA will be protected.
