PURPOSE: Public hearing to address proposed amendments to North Dakota Administrative Code (NDAC) chapter 33.1-21-01. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to adopt rules for licensing of current and future onsite wastewater treatment system installers. The proposed rulemaking implements bill number 2267, enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning onsite wastewater treatment system and installations.
