

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE INTENT TO ISSUE A  
RADIATION CONTROL PROGRAM  
RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE TO OPERATE

Take notice that the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality (NDDEQ) proposes to issue a Radioactive Materials license to White Owl Energy Services, Inc. for a radioactive material processing facility. The license will allow authorization for the processing of Naturally Occurring Radioactive Material (NORM) and Technologically Enhanced Natural Occurring Radioactive Material (TENORM) at 5756 10th Ave. NW, Tioga, North Dakota, 58854.

Preliminary evaluations made by NDDEQ staff indicate that White Owl Energy Services, Inc. will comply with all applicable North Dakota Radiological Health Rules and there will be no significant detrimental effects to members of the public or the environment.

A public hearing will be held on Sept. 10, 2026 at the Tioga Community Center, 410 6th St. NE, Tioga, North Dakota. Oral and written comments will be accepted during the hearing. The schedule for the hearing is as follows:

5:30 p.m. – Public information meeting

6:30 p.m. – Public hearing for draft radioactive materials license
