

**Training Event: Introduction to the New UST Rules**  
**Effective Date – April 1, 2018**

April 1, 2018 is the implementation date of the new North Dakota Underground Storage Tank rules and regulations. Six regional presentations will acquaint owners, operators, contractors and installers with what the new rules and regulations entail. Each regional presentation will contain the same material

The information that will be provided is very similar to what was covered by the previous presentations which were held in 2017. The main difference, is that with an effective date of April 1, 2018, specific regulation compliance dates have been set and resource documents have been finalized. These will be described in detail.
