RE : Reevaluation of Existing Limits for AOP-28376

The Cargill, Inc. – Cargill Oilseeds Processing plant (Cargill or facility) is an oilseed crushing facility that produces highly refined vegetable oils from sunflower seeds, canola, flax, and other oil seeds. The facility currently operates under Air Title V Permit to Operate (PTO) No. AOP-28376 v5.0 issued on August 6, 2019, which is extended until the permit renewal is issued.

During the Title V PTO renewal, the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality – Division of Air Quality (Department) reevaluated the emission limits associated with the facility. Upon evaluation of the existing limits provided in the current Title V, and in consideration of historical operations and emissions testing performed at the facility, the Department has determined that it is appropriate to rescind emissions limits associated with several previously issued permits.¹ Concurrent with the rescindment of emissions limits, the Department proposes to issue a corrective permit action which incorporates all appropriate and necessary limits under ACP-18261 v1.0, Table 3-1.

There are no physical changes at the facility, no changes to regulatory applicability, no new permit requirements, or changes in potential emissions with this permit action. Additionally, this permit action does not modify, remove, or add any BACT limits. The facility will remain a PSD major source and remain subject to Title V.
