All samples are required to be collected in containers provided by the Chemistry Laboratory. To obtain a collection kit please call our Sample Receipt Coordinator at 701-328-6140.

The General Water analyses require the sample to be returned to the laboratory within 48 hours of collection. These analyses take approximately two weeks to complete but may take longer due to heavy sample load and program priority. Once completed, a sample report will be mailed to your address.
