Permit to Operate Fees

DATE : January 2, 2018

In accordance with the Air Pollution Control Rules of the State of North Dakota, NDAC 33-15-23-04.8, the major source (Title V) permit to operate annual fee rates and limits will be adjusted based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the 12-month period ending August 31 each year. The average, unadjusted CPI for all items during the period that ended August 31, 2017 was +1.9 percent. The table below lists the fee changes.

Item	2017 Rate/Ton or Minimum Fee (\$)	CPI Adjustment Factor	2018 Rate/Ton or Minimum Fee (\$)
Regulated contaminants for fee calculations*, other than HAP (per ton)	14.95	+1.9%	15.23
Section 112(b) contaminants, HAP (per ton)	31.14	+1.9%	31.73
Minimum fee	622.71	+1.9%	634.54

* Excludes greenhouse gases

The adjusted fee rates are effective January 1, 2018 and will be used to calculate the July 2018 annual bill based on calendar year 2017 actual emissions.
